Fresh from announcing that they will be building their first ever LTE hotspot in Australia this week, Google has now revealed they will begin rolling out a number of new GSM and HSPA+ LTE hotspots in South America. The new devices come hot on the heels of Google continuing its commitment to bring 4G to the rest of the world. Since the 4G age came to the world's smartphones back in 2008 with the introduction of the Galaxy S, many manufacturers have been keen to bring 4G to as many people as possible. For developers, 4G is a much quicker and cheaper method of providing data than the much slower WLAN method they had been using up until now, and on that basis it is fair to say that the importance of 4G and the benefits it brings to consumers, manufacturers and developers will only continue to grow. It is only to be expected, therefore, that more companies around the world are now committing to bring 4G to as many people as possible as soon as possible. Many companies, including Google, seem to be looking beyond selling hardware to consumers to also be able to sell software applications – and on that basis it makes sense for them to look at the best way of doing so. Google has been the first major company to begin pushing for the introduction of LTE data in as many places as possible, announcing new hotspots in San Francisco, Paris, London, and Mumbai. Now Google has revealed it is also looking to expand its reach to South America by rolling out a number of new LTE hotspots, with its first devices being manufactured by Brazilian company Tiago and distributed by Google to three different local carriers – Brazilian operator GT, Brazilian mobile network E Telecom, and Spanish network Telefónica. “We are excited to be offering a new type of device that brings ultra-fast browsing, entertainment and apps to devices across the US and more countries internationally. Our first LTE devices will be available in Brazil, Mexico and throughout South
